










Helping Homes Diaper Program: Diaper Drive

Helping Homes: Emergency Child Care

Short-term voluntary care for children ages 6 weeks to 12 years of age for parents who lack support and resources to provide safe childcare. Helping Homes is a confidential emergency service available free of charge for 2 to 72 hours of care, 24 hours a day, and 365 days per year. If you have a client that you foresee needing Helping Homes, please be proactive in having paperwork filled out ahead of time when placement is needed. We will still help in time of need to expedite the process.
