Services Include

Individual Parent Education

Sessions are available to any parent and/ or guardian. Sessions are an hour in length meeting once a week, over a period of 6 to 8 sessions. Sessions are scheduled on the availability of the parent educator and the parent or guardian. These sessions include topics of parent education identified by the referring agency (if applicable) and the need and want of the parent. A sliding fee scale is available based on gross income and circumstance. Sessions are held in person in our office as well as via Zoom.

Group Parenting Education

Sessions, emphasizing safe discipline methods, are taught by professional parent educators for parents challenged by multiple risk factors. Parenting classes are incorporated into Parents Forever divorce education and local county detention centers including Freeborn, Mower, Steele, Goodhue, Rice, and Wabasha County.

Parent2Parent
